

What you need:

- Scissors
- Straight Pin
- Pencil with an eraser
- Pencil or Pen (to draw with)



How to get started:

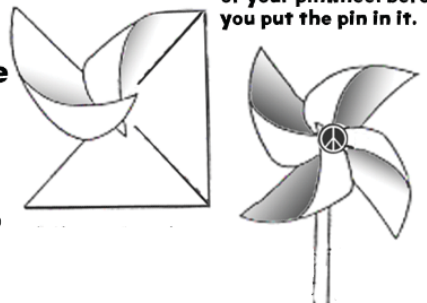
Carefully cut out the pinwheel square on this page. Following the lines on the template, cut in from all four corners, leaving 2 inches of the center uncut.



Cut out this peace sign and put it in the center of your pinwheel before you put the pin in it.

To create the pinwheel:

Gently bend (don't fold) one of the cut corners to the center point. Skip the next corner and bend the next one. Skip and bend until four points meet in the center. Then, stick the straight pin through the four points on the back of the pinwheel. Stick the pin into the pencil eraser. Find some wind to test it out.
